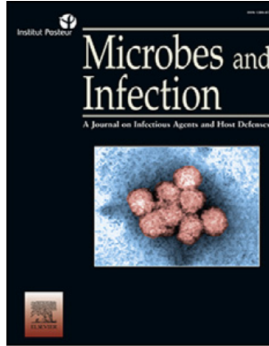

Messages from the ~~second~~ International Conference on Clinical Metagenomics (ICCMg2)

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Some take-home messages

- CMg spans more and more fields: cancer, strain level
- Which raises more than ever questions about communication to clinicians and ethical issues.
- In sepsis: new perspectives with cell free metagenomics.
- WGS is now a mature field (100k genomes!), challenge is now the reporting.
- Pivotal role of microbiota in personalized medicine
- Understand that I should have my microbiota sequenced before I could eat swiss cheese or chocolate

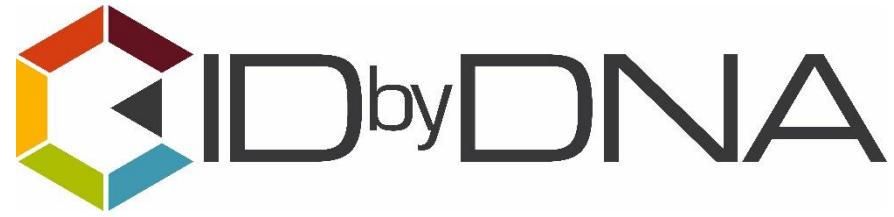

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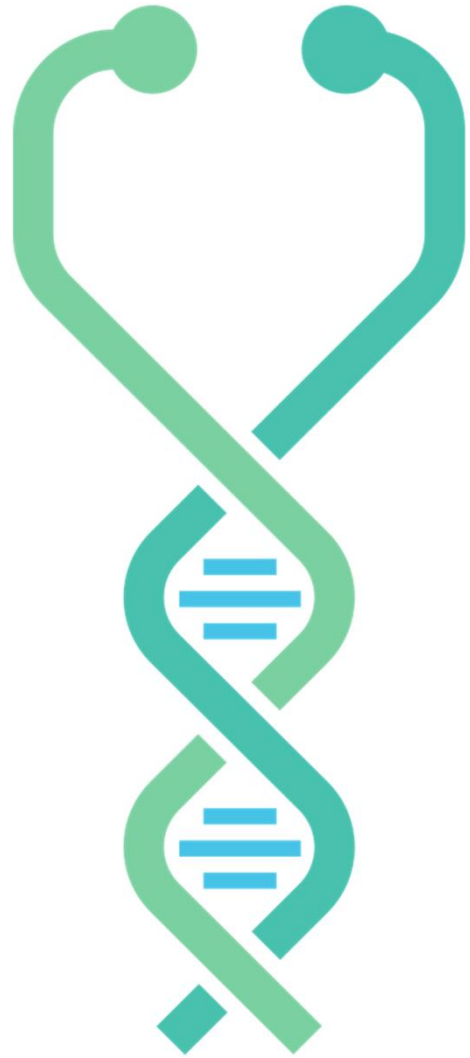
