Welcome to the 10th ICCMg10!

We are thrilled to continue hosting the International Conference on Clinical Metagenomics (ICCMg) in Geneva. This marks the ninth edition, with two previous conferences successfully held online due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

The ICCMg conferences have provided a platform for the clinical metagenomics community to foster both scientific advancements and social interactions. Six conference proceedings have been published, further contributing to the field's knowledge base.

We are pleased to announce that ICCMg10 will take place on November 6th and 7th, a time suitable for attendees from diverse professional backgrounds.

The scientific agenda for ICCMg10 is structured into the following sessions:

- Dark Matter: Explore the role of culture-based approaches in clinical metagenomics, unravel novel viruses, and understand the human genome in gut metagenomes.
- Respiratory Microbiota: Leverage cell-free DNA for pneumonia diagnosis, explore the respiratory microbiota and immune response, and gain insights into the respiratory microbiota in intensive care unit patients.
- Beyond Life clinical metagenomics: Gain metagenomic insights into pathogens associated with neonatal deaths, apply metagenomics on (very) old samples.
- Phages: Uncover viral diversity in the healthy infant gut, explore the phageome and the skin microbiota.
- Complex Matter: Assess the population-level impacts of antibiotic usage on the human gut microbiome, address the challenges of multi-omics in metagenomic studies, and explore machine learning for microbiologists.

The conference will feature invited speakers, abstract and poster presentations, and a conference dinner on the shores of Lake Geneva.
